

INSTALLING THE FRIDAY BULLETIN

CHURCH · PREPARED FOR VOLUNTEER-RUN COMMUNITY CHURCHES

Every Friday, when someone drops the bulletin file, the site rereads it and republishes services, songs, scripture, and the header. A person still drops the file. The lyric overlay is a different, still-partial piece.

WHAT RUNS, IN ORDER

1**FRIDAY'S BULLETIN IS DROPPED**

The same file they print for the pews. One upload. A person does that.

2**THE SITE REREADS IT**

Services, songs, scripture, the header. Off the PDF, not retyped.

3**IF A LINE WILL NOT READ, IT STAYS BLANK**

A person fills that line. The site does not guess a hymn title.

4**LYRICS STAY MARKED PARTIAL**

The overlay is built, still running demo lyrics. This job is the bulletin.

5**A PERSON STILL DROPS THE FILE**

The site does not fetch the copier.

THE STEP THAT STAYS YOURS

A person still drops Friday's PDF. The site does not fetch the copier. The volunteer who used to type it now drops the file and looks at the preview. That stays a person.

WHAT IT READS, AND WHAT IT DOES THE WORK WITH

- ◆ Friday's bulletin PDF — The same document they already print for the pews. One five-minute upload.
- ◆ What the site rereads — Services. Songs. Scripture. The header. Off the PDF, not retyped.
- ◆ What stays a person — Dropping Friday's file. Looking at the preview. A blank line if it will not read.
- ◆ What this film does not claim — Lyrics on the stream. That overlay is built, still running demo lyrics.

It touches Friday's bulletin file · the church website · the songbook files they already keep. Nothing else.

WHERE IT IS WRONG, AND WHAT IT PRINTS INSTEAD**IF A LINE ON THE PDF WILL NOT READ**

Leave it blank. A person types that one. Do not guess.

IF YOU WANT TO NAME THE PARISH

The client is blinded. The film refuses.

IF YOU WANT TO SELL THE LYRICS OVERLAY

It is built, still running demo lyrics. Do not claim it is done.

IF YOU WANT THE WORDS IT WILL NOT SAY

Replaced the volunteers. Illegal. In violation. The page refuses all three.

FITTED TODAY — READY

The Friday PDF upload works end to end. The live lyric overlay is built but still running demo lyrics. This film is the bulletin job, not the lyrics.

THE PROMISE THIS INSTALL MAKES

We only claim the Friday upload. Lyrics stay marked partial. History portal is a different piece. We never name a parish. We never say we replaced the volunteers.

WHAT CHANGES ON YOUR SIDE

- ◆ Sunday gets on the site from Friday's PDF, not from someone typing the bulletin in again
- ◆ Services, songs, scripture, and the header come off the same document the pews already get
- ◆ A person still drops the file. The site does not publish itself from the copier
- ◆ Lyrics on the stream stay marked partial. This film does not sell them as done

It files nothing and contacts no agency on your behalf. It is not legal or compliance advice, and it is not a guarantee. It reports what ran, when, and what it could not see — and a person decides what happens next.
